### Andrew's Pants

This unique sculpture by Peter Wagner is a tribute to the outstanding graphics and painter Andrew Nowacki. On the building at 3 Wolności Square, where the artist lived and worked for 50 years, appears a sculpted, realistic pair of jeans. The sculpture is a reference to the artist's famous series "Udzinsowieni".

### Metal construction of Nicolaus Copernicus

This was established during the first Bydgoszcz nationwide outdoor sculptors' workshop (August-September 1973.) The author of the spatial metal structure – Maria Chudoba-Wisniewska – is now deceased. The sculpture weighs 864 kg and measures 4.57 m.

### The Polish Theatre

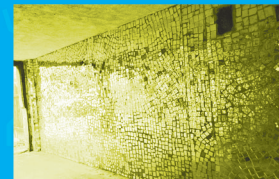

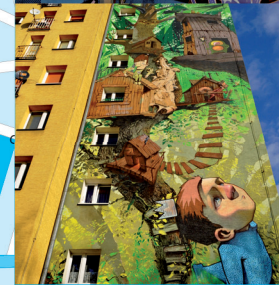
